



NOTE: The 12-Week Curriculum is to be repeated throughout the year as the children progress. Repetition is very beneficial for learning and so we recommend that lesson plans are used as needed, as many times as you deem necessary.

Our curriculum is designed to work with the following developmental areas:

Supported Sitters: Typically from birth until around 6 months **Sitters/Crawlers:** Anywhere from 5 months to 12 months **Standers/Walkers:** As early as 10 months to 18 months
